

## English Language Test Scores

The medium of instruction at NUS is English. To benefit from an NUS education, you are required to have a minimum level of English proficiency. For certain qualifications, you are required to furnish additional English Language test scores in addition to the high school qualifications.

Applicants may present any of the following to fulfil the English Language requirement:

The validity of C1 Advanced/Cambridge English: Advanced, PTE Academic, TOEFL and/or IELTS scores is two years. Only scores obtained in the two years leading up to the application deadline will be considered.

The validity of MUET score is five years. Only scores issued in the five years leading up to the application deadline will be considered.

The NUS institution code for TOEFL is 0786. The score report must reach the Office of Admissions by your application closing date, failing which your application will be deemed incomplete and will not be processed.

# IELTS Indicator score is not accepted.

\* NUS only accepts TOEFL iBT scores from a single test date, not MyBest scores.
