Admissions Requirements

We adopt a holistic approach in selecting applicants on individual merits. Applicants are required to meet:

- the university entrance requirements (using international curricula or regional/national curricula);
- the English language requirements; and,
- if any, the programme entrance requirements.

The following public examination results are recognised as meeting the minimum English Language requirements stipulated by the University:

Fees and Scholarships

Fees

The tuition fee of full-time undergraduate programmes for 2024/25 is HK\$42,100 for local students and HK\$160,000 for non-local students¹ respectively. Fees are to be paid in two equal instalments.

1. Definition of non-local students:

Non-local students are defined as persons entering Hong Kong for the purpose of education with any of the following student visa/ entry permit issued by the Director of Immigration of the Hong Kong Government:

- student visa/ entry permit
- visa under the Immigration Arrangements for Non-local Graduates
- dependent visa, who are aged 18 years old or above when they were issued with such visa

Those who do not belong to this category will be considered as local applicants. Please check with the Admissions Office on your local/non-local status when in doubt.

Under the current immigration policy, nationals from Afghanistan, Cuba and North Korea(DPRK) may not be able to obtain a student visa to study in Hong Kong. For details, please click here (https://www.immd.gov.hk/eng/services/visas/study.html).
