

English proficiency tests

The following tests satisfy our minimum English language requirements for undergraduate, postgraduate and research (HDR) courses.

The test must have been undertaken within **two years** of application, however, they may be used for entry until the next semester intake.

The results from multiple English language proficiency tests will not be combined to meet the required standard.



Special Tertiary Admissions Test (STAT) Written English section where only the Written English component was taken, results are valid for two years from the date of testing, however maybe used for entry until the next immediate semester intake. STAT format from 1 May 2010: 140

Previous STAT format between 1996 to April 2010: 145

Malaysian University English Test (MUET)

Band 4 is required to meet IELTS 6.0 (6.0); Band 4 and no less than 200 in aggregate score is required to meet IELTS 6.5 (6.0); Band 5 is required to meet IELTS 7.0 (7.0).

Germany DAAD (Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst)

B2 (4 stars) in meeting minimum English (i.e. IELTS 6.5 with no band less than 6.0); or with C1 (5 stars) in meeting higher English criteria.
